



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










Cut out all the pieces. Choose the eyes, nose and mouth, then glue them to your pumpkin! OR draw your own face!





Trace the word "Fall" To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under heaven. Ecclesiastes 3:1










Pumpkin Cupcake Recipe







Now we make pumpkin pie, pumpkin bread, pumpkin cupcakes, roast the seeds, and carve them.


