


Printing Instructions:

- 1. Save file to computer
- 2.Select to print "Actual Size"
- 3.Be sure "Fit to Page" is not selected
- 4.Be sure to print the correct orientation: "landscape"
- 5.Once printed, measure the box above to be sure you printed the correct size. If the box does not measure 1 inch high and 1 inch wide, go back and check your printer settings.







AMERICAN GIRL SWIMSUIT PATTERN


Repurpose an old suit or use new material

INSTRUCTIONS


OPTION 1: Pictured on the left is a little girl's swimsuit being repurposed into an American Girl swimsuit. If you are able to use an old swimsuit, match up the finished edges and cut pieces exactly to size.


OPTION 2: If using new material, <u>add a seam allowance</u> to the pattern. *This pattern will work best using a swimsuit like material or knit that has a stretch to it.*


- 1. <u>For the bottom:</u> Hem around all edges (if new material) and sew side seams with right sides together.
- 2. For top: Hem edges (if new material)
- 3. Place **triangular top pieces** on top of each other with right sides facing same direction and baste straight across bottom.
- 4. With right sides together, sew the side of the **rectangular pieces** together to form a circle.
- Hem top and bottom edge of rectangular pieces that now form a circle.
- 6. Pin the **rectangular pieces** to the basted edge of the swimsuit top, placing seam in step 4 on the side.
- 7. Attach straps to top
- 3. For beach bag: sew triangle pieces, right sides together leaving an opening at the top. Attach straps.




STRAPS CUT 2
