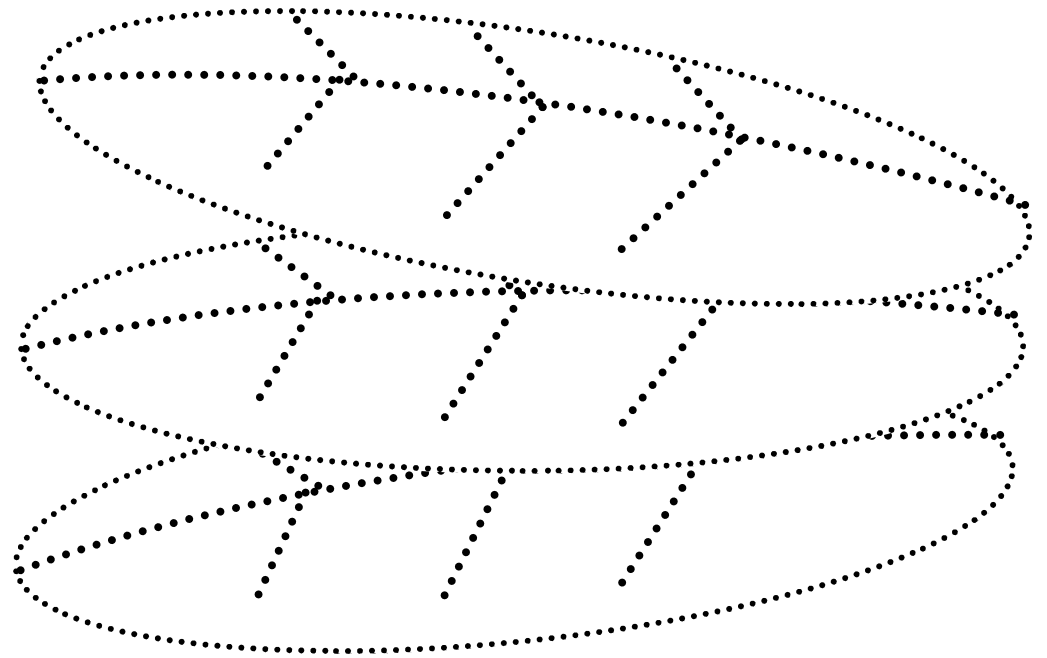

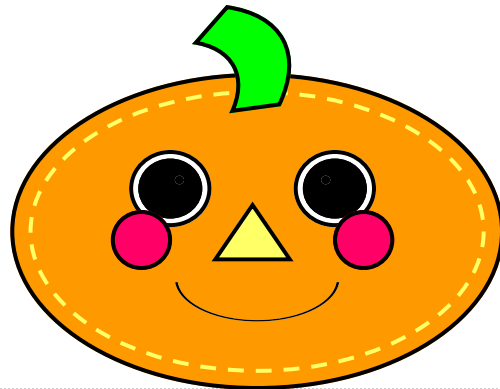
On that first Thanksgiving,
